Kindergarten Gradual Entry.

Wednesday, September 6th, Thursday, September 7th & Friday, September 8th

****Kindergarten students DO NOT come on Tuesday, September 5th ****

- The children will attend school in small groups, at a different time each day, in order to experience the different aspects of the day (i.e., start of the day routines, lunch playtime and eating time; afternoon playtime and end of the day routines).
- Families will meet teachers at **the back of the school black top undercover area**

Monday, September 11th & Tuesday, September 12th

- Classes will be finalized at the end of the day on Friday, Sept 8th. Information regarding the following week will be communicated by your classroom teacher on Friday, Sept 8th.
- All students will attend and meet in their line-up spots for the start of their day at 8:40am. Dismissal on these two days will be 1:00pm. Students need to bring a healthy snack, water bottle and lunch.

Wednesday, September 16th

- 8:35 – 2:48- Regular school hours

Snacks / Lunches

- Snacks should be “healthy” choices that can be unpacked easily and eaten independently (i.e. raw veggies, pieces of fruit, crackers, cheese, raisins, small muffin, etc.).
- Lunches should follow similar guidelines please. Children are encouraged to have water in a labeled reusable bottle/ cup in their lunch each day rather than juice. Note that we are not able to heat lunches for children.
- Please use **re-usable LABELED food containers** as much as possible, as we send home all packaging back home in the student’s lunch kits.

School Supplies

- Each child is asked to have a pair of **clean velcro** or **slip-on** running shoes that can remain at school for inside use only. Stay tuned for class communication.
- Each child should have a **reasonably-sized backpack**. Please ensure that it is large enough to carry a lunch kit, library books, notices, extra clothing, etc. to and from school, as this will really help your child to keep their belongings organized.
- All school supplies have been organized and pre-purchased by our Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) unless families opted out. **Stay tuned for class communication for payment.**
