As we wrap up January, we're grateful for the crisp, sunny days that have brightened our play outdoors. It has been a productive month across the school, filled with meaningful learning and professional growth. This month, our Social Emotional Learning (SEL) school-wide focus has been on emotional management—helping students recognize, understand, and express their emotions in healthy ways. Through classroom lessons, assemblies, and small-group activities, students have practiced:

- Naming their feelings with greater accuracy
- Using calming strategies such as breathing techniques, mindfulness, and movement breaks
- Reflecting on how their emotions influence their decisions
- Building empathy and strengthening peer relationships

We've already seen wonderful examples of students beginning to use these tools independently, especially during moments of challenge. Thank you for reinforcing these skills at home—your partnership makes a meaningful difference.

Our staff members are engaged in their own learning this month with an 8-week focus on Physical Ed in partnership with PISE and a 3-part series in literacy professional development. Teachers are exploring evidence-based reading instruction in early literacy and strategies for strengthening fluency in the intermediate grades. This shared learning is already shaping daily instruction, and we're excited to see how these strategies will continue to enhance students' literacy growth.

As we approach the month of February, we have several exciting updates and events to share with you:

**Basketball:** Intramural Basketball has started at Brentwood for Grades 4/5 who practice and play games at lunch hours and will participate in the District Jamboree on March 6. We also have a new MEMEXÁL Caterpillar girls team that has been generously sponsored by Coastal Wave Basketball. They practice Wednesdays after school and will participate in a jamboree in April.

**Swim Club:** We're excited to share that our school's Swim Club has been off to a great start! We are already seeing so much progress! The District Swim Meet is on March 12. More details to come.

**Maple Man:** The Maple Man is coming to Brentwood on Feb 12! He offers a fantastic introduction to French Canadian culture, maple taffy and storytelling that ties in beautifully with French Canadian winter traditions.
